The choir has long been associated with high standards of music-making. We sing a wide range of repertoire, spanning from the 16th Century to recently published compositions.

What does the choir do?

We help lead the congregation in worship each Sunday morning during term-time. This includes singing hymns, psalms, and choir pieces.

During services, children take time out to work on developing their musicianship skills through the 'Voice for Life' scheme, and also to work on their music theory.

We practise on a Friday evenings and Sunday mornings, before the service.

Occasionally, we sing at other special services and events, at Holy Trinity and other churches.



Cathedral Visits

We visit a cathedral at least once a year, usually for a weekend. Whilst 'in residence', we provide music at services whilst the cathedral choir are on holiday. In recent years we have visited: Exeter, Bristol, Brecon, Hereford, Worcester, St David's & others.
